

ACTION PLAN 2020



LEADERSHIP, ADVOCACY & EMPOWERMENT

- Secure funding to support leadership and community engagement for Northcote zero waste initiative
- Explore potential resourcing and establishment of a zero waste school/community liaison role
- All Northcote school students to visit zero waste zone
- Activations & interventions for behaviour change, including awareness raising re. litter
- Explore utilising town centre space (e.g. Cool Bar) for recycling hub/reuse space/maker space or demonstration site
- 3 bin system supported into Northcote
- Intermediate and other local schools
- Support library to engage with public about zero waste
- Host local Teacher Cluster Hui about zero waste
- Collect data/ share stats/ collect case studies / audit review of waste systems
- Promote re-useables and shared goods
- Engage with business association
- Support and promote repair cafes
- Innovation / Do-learn-do/ Prototyping initiatives
- Continued engagement and co-design with wider stakeholders
- Wider community awareness, engagement and co-design on the para kore kaupapa



ACTIVATION & COMMUNICATION

- Storytelling initiatives

FOOD SYSTEMS

- Local food and garden scraps reprocessing sites
- Increase composting in small places or at home workshops
- Use transformation to establish systems to grow 'food destination' reputation with a focus on zero waste and increase consistency between systems
- Fast test food security systems that support food waste reduction (related to above)
- Support expansion of Council food scraps service



DEVELOPMENT PLANNING

- Development agreements
- Build on Homestar 6 accreditation for warm dry homes to incorporate waste systems
- Pilot LCA – Life Cycle Assessment
- Homestar – household waste systems considered by developers – highlighting internal and external considerations for food waste storage and collection
- MUDS – Work with developers and waste contractors to devise a workable template for MUDS around planning for waste storage
- Spec.guidelines for Kāinga Ora homes – standardised to include waste sorting bins in kitchen
- Maintain engagement with Waste Solutions
- Advice for body corps and tenancy agreements on expected ways of occupying commercial or residential properties in Multi unit
- Use developments with waste systems in place
- Green Star Communities – Community User Guide
- Assess current Maintenance & Operational waste contracts, current project waste contracts



DE/CONSTRUCTION

- Construction waste management plan and >75% diversion
- Support concrete-asphalt recovery
- Soft stripping demolition
- Demolition/salvage sites
- Recovery system
- Follow the waste hierarchy: reuse, relocation –deconstruction,
- demolition with salvage
